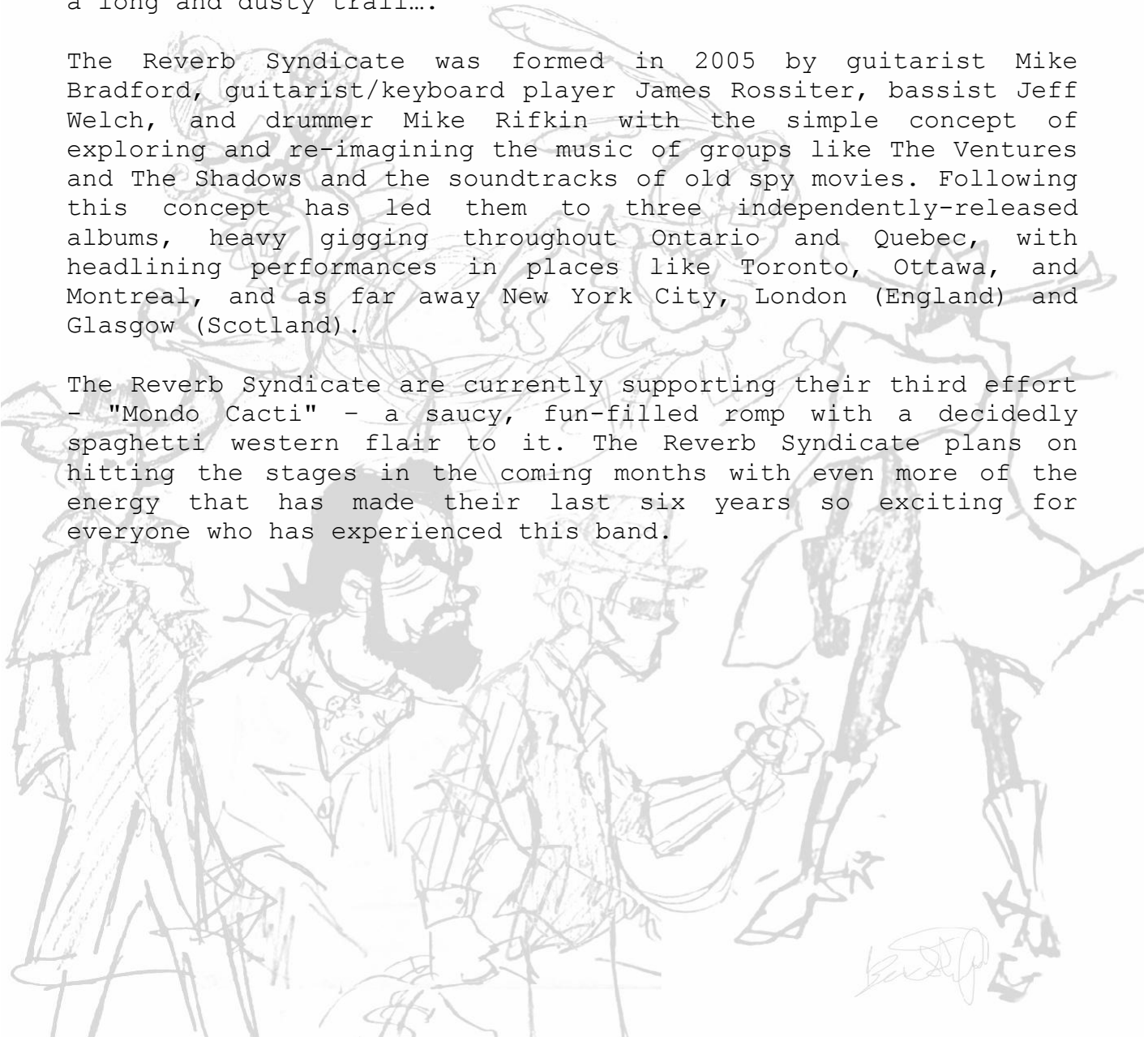


In 2006, they introduced the masses to their blend of sixties spy movie music and classic surf rock with their debut album, "Operation: Jet Set!". In 2007, they blasted off into the stars with the space themed "Sputnik A-Go-Go". Now The Reverb Syndicate is ready to begin a new adventure, one that begins on a long and dusty trail...

The Reverb Syndicate was formed in 2005 by guitarist Mike Bradford, guitarist/keyboard player James Rossiter, bassist Jeff Welch, and drummer Mike Rifkin with the simple concept of exploring and re-imagining the music of groups like The Ventures and The Shadows and the soundtracks of old spy movies. Following this concept has led them to three independently-released albums, heavy gigging throughout Ontario and Quebec, with headlining performances in places like Toronto, Ottawa, and Montreal, and as far away New York City, London (England) and Glasgow (Scotland).

The Reverb Syndicate are currently supporting their third effort - "Mondo Cacti" - a saucy, fun-filled romp with a decidedly spaghetti western flair to it. The Reverb Syndicate plans on hitting the stages in the coming months with even more of the energy that has made their last six years so exciting for everyone who has experienced this band.

- ✦ The Reverb Syndicate have released three albums to date. Their debut album, "Operation: Jet Set!", was released in 2006 with the follow-up, "Sputnik A-Go-Go", coming in 2007. Their most recent effort, "Mondo Cacti" was released in 2011.
- ✦ All three albums are available worldwide on iTunes, Amazon.com, CDBaby.com, fine Ottawa record stores, and the band's website.
- ✦ The Reverb Syndicate has released a music video animated by Ben Stanford for their track "I Am the New Number Two", which can be found on the band's website, Facebook, and YouTube.
- ✦ The band has been deployed on numerous international missions, covering London, Edinburgh, Glasgow, Brighton, and New York City. Canadian cities played include Toronto, Montreal, Ottawa, Guelph, Kitchener, Oshawa, and Sudbury.
